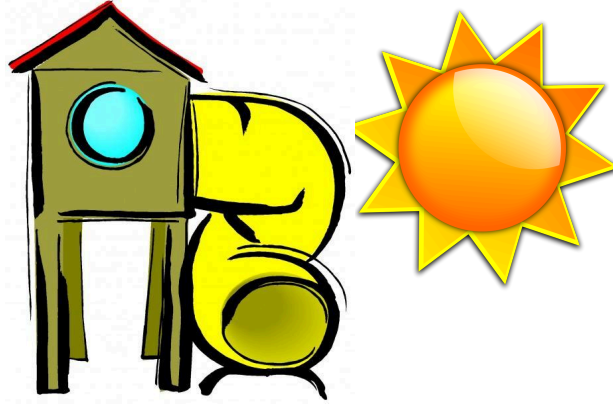




Little Academy Preschool



Dear Summer Camp families,

Welcome to Little Academy Summer Camp. We are happy that you have chosen our camp to meet your needs as a family. We look forward to providing a fun filled summer to all of our campers.

This handbook will provide you with an understanding of what our summer program looks like.

Schedule: Little Academy Summer Camp runs Monday through Wednesday 9:00-3:00.

Summer 2026: June 22-24, June 29-July 1, July 13-15, July 20-22, July 27-29, August 3-5, August 10-12

Please note: We cannot offer early drop of or late pickup.

Cost: Camp is \$180 per week due at the time of registration. All camps are nonrefundable.

Forms that must be returned: A registration form, immunization record, and full payment for spot(s) to be held. Forms must be mailed to PO Box 281.

Needs list for summer camp: Each child will need sneakers or inside shoes, two snacks, lunch and a water bottle daily. Please label your child's belongings.

Sunscreen MUST be applied prior to camp.

Classroom Sanitation: The classroom is cleaned and toys and surfaces are disinfected on a daily basis. We also follow health and state regulations to keep a clean and healthy environment. All children **must** wash hands upon arrival into the classroom.

Choice Time: Choice time is a time in the classroom for children to explore and learn throughout numerous activities. Play practices and enhances concentration, imagination, and creativity.

Snack/Lunch Time: Food allergies are accommodated if your child has food allergies please, be sure to provide an action plan from your pediatrician.

Playground Time: Outside activity is a central part of a child's development and learning experience. Physical activities include running, climbing, skipping, and bouncing enhances a child's large motor development. Outside activity is a beneficial way to build a child's social and gross motor skills along with the joy in nature and having free play outside. We try to be outside as much as possible. Please be sure your child has proper gear for the weather.

Visitors: Little Academy has an open door policy. However, for safety purposes, always check in upon arrival at the school. All new visitors will be expected to show ID. This policy is meant to keep all students safe.

Illness Guidelines and Health Policy: If your child has a fever, has vomited, or had diarrhea, please keep them home. They may return when they are 24 hours symptom free.

Behavior Management

Our goal of discipline is to assist and guide your children in the development of self control. Teachers will discipline in a consistent way, based on the understanding of varying developmental levels. Simple and understandable rules will be established so that the expectations and limitations will be clearly defined. Discipline will have constructive and natural consequences. Discipline methods may include redirection, separating the child from the situation, or encouraging and reinforcing to gain appropriate behavior and efforts.

Clothing:

Children should come to camp comfortably dressed and with clothing that is appropriate to the weather. Please mark all clothing and other belongings with your child's name. Please leave a spare outfit in your child's backpack in a storage Ziploc bag with your child's name on it. We do have A/C inside so a sweatshirt may be needed when chilly.

Absences:

When your child is going to be absent, please be sure to let us know. You may call 849-9384, call or text 242-4547, or leave a voicemail on either phone. You may also provide written absence via email.

Confidentiality

We respect the rights of the student, parents and families. If you need to discuss something, please know so that we can offer a private place to do so.
